BYLAW NO.1

At the first quarterly meeting of the council of the municipality county of Ottawa-Division No.3, comprising the townships of Bristol, Clarendon, Litchfield, Calumet Island, Allumette Island, held in the house of Mr. Samuel Moorhead in the township of Litchfield, on the 13th of December, 1847. Councillors representing:

- Bristol: William Craig, Patrick Kehoe
- Clarendon: Thomas Corrigan, Thomas Wilson
- Litchfield: Alfred Lancaster, Samuel Moorhead
- Calumet Is.: F.X. Bastien, Thomas McVeagh
- Allumette Is.: Andrew Whalen, Donald McNeill

Mr. Craig and Mr. Bastien being absent. The secretary-treasurer, Mr. John Morton, being also present.

Moved by Thomas Corrigan, seconded by Patrick Kehoe as a bylaw of this council that a fine of five dollars (currency) shall be impose on any of the members of the body who shall absent himself from any of the general or special meetings of the council without assigning a just and satisfactory cause therefore.
