BYLAW NO.2

At a quarterly meeting held in the house of Mr. Samuel Moorhead, township of Litchfield, on the 15th day of June, 1852, at which meeting are present the mayors Thomas Corrigan, Alexander Smart, A. Griffin, Thomas McVeagh, A. Stewart, A.G. Ross, D. McGillis, Samuel Moorhead, John Stewart. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Moved by Mr. Ross, seconded by Mr. McGillis, that a committee will be formed out of this council for the purpose of drafting a bylaw for the establishing of roads according to law and as far as possible to prevent further carelling (quarrelling) among the inhabitants of this municipality.

Moved by Mr. A. Stewart, seconded by Mr. J. Stewart, that mayors A.G. Ross, D. McGillis, and Mr. A. Griffin will form the committee for the above purposes.

Moved by Mr. Smart, seconded by Mr. McVeagh, that the bylaw proposed this day by the above committee be sanctioned by this council, and that the secretary-treasurer will forward two copies of the same to each township, and will cause the same to be posted up according to law.

Carried unanimsously
