At a special meeting held at the village of Portage du Fort, on the 15th of January, 1856, at the hour of ten o'clock A.M., at which meeting are present His Worship Warden W. L. Gray, mayor of Allumette Island, and the following county councillors:

- F.X. Bastien mayor of Calumet Island
- Robert Shirley mayor of Bristol
- John Beahan mayor of Onslow
- George Bryson mayor of Mansfield
- John Dale mayor of Clarendon
- P.F. Fox mayor of Litchfield

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

A bylaw to levy for county purposes one sixth of a penny on the £ for the present year.

Moved by George Bryson, seconded by F.X. Bastien that one sixth of a penny on the £ be levied, for county purposes, for the present year.
