BYLAW NO.2

At a general session held in Portage du Fort, on the 11 day of December, 1856, at the hour of nine of the clock A.M., at which meeting are present P.F. Fox, mayor of Litchfield, acting as Warden (W.L. Gray, warden, being absent), and the following councillors:

- John Dale mayor of Clarendon
- John Beahan mayor of Onslow
- George Bryson mayor of Mansfield
- Robert Shirley mayor of Bristol

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Moved by George Bryson, seconded by John Dale and resolved that the following bylaw be adopted:

Be it therefore enacted and ordained by the authority of the same that the sum of three thousand pounds (£3,000) be borrowed from the Government on the strength of the rateable property of said county payable in twenty years at the usual interest, and the interest payable yearly, and that a sinking fund be made of two percent on the whole.

Carried unanimously.
