BYLAW NO.5

At a quarterly session held in Portage du Fort on the 11th day of March, 1857, at the hour of ten of the clock A.M., at which meeting are present His Worship Warden P.F. Fox, mayor of Litchfield, and the following county councillors:

- Robert Shirley mayor of Bristol
- George Bryson mayor of Mansfield
- John Dale mayor of Clarendon
- F.X. Bastien mayor of Calumet Island
- John Beahan mayor of Onslow
- John B. Poupore mayor of Chicherster!

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Whereas the return of the different municipalities in relation to the bylaw passed on the 11th day of December, 1856, to borrow the amount of £3000 to open up the county road, has been rescinded, and the majority of the municipalities have disapproved of the same, it is expedient and is hereby enacted that the said bylaw and resolution connected through be and are hereby annuled.

Moved by John Beahan, seconded by John B. Poupore that a bylaw be passed annulling a resolution passed on the 11th day of December, 1856, by this council in relation to borrow money from the government.

Carried unanimously.
