BYLAW NO.7

At a quarterly session held in Portage du Fort on the 10th day of June, 1857, at the hour of ten o'clock forenoon, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden P.F. Fox, mayor of Litchfield and the following county councillors:

- Robert Shirley mayor of Bristol
- John Dale mayor of Clarendon
- John Beahan mayor of Onslow
- Thomas Harrington mayor of Sheen

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Moved by John Dale, seconded by John Beahan that whereas it is necessary and expedient to alter a certain portion of a bylaw passed at the last session of this council (12th day of March, 1857), it is enacted that the sum of 15/s be charged for certificates for tavern license, and 60/s for certificates from store keepers, in the township of Onslow, instead of 20/s for tavern license as stated in by law last session of council.
