BYLAW NO.10

At an adjourned session held in Portage du Fort on Thursday the 13th day of January, 1859, at the hour of eight o'clock in the forenoon, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden John Poupore, mayor of Chichester, and the following county councillors:

- John F. Coghlan mayor of Waltham
- Patrick F. Fox mayor of Litchfield
- Thomas Harrington mayor of Sheen
- James Shaw mayor of Clarendon
- Robert Shirley mayor of Bristol
- John Beahan mayor of Onslow

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Moved by mayor Harrington, seconded by mayor Shaw and resolved that the county rate for the current year be one half penny on the pound on each pound on the valuation rolls of each local municipality on this county; that the amount so raised after the deduction of the current year's expenses be divided amongst the township in the proportion in which it was paid said sums to be expended on the county road under the direction of this council and that a bylaw be framed and passed accordingly.
