BYLAW NO.11

At a general session held in Portage du Fort on Wednesday the 1st day of June, 1859, at which meeting are present P.F. Fox, mayor of Litchfield, acting as warden in the absence of Mr. John Poupore, and the following county councillors:

- John F. Coghlan mayor of Waltham
- John Beahan mayor of Calumet Island
- Mr. Ross mayor of ?
- Mr. Kelly mayor of ?

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Moved by mayor Coghlan, seconded by mayor Kelly that an eighth of a penny on the pound on each pound on the valuation roll of each municipality in this county be levied for the current year for county purposes and that this bylaw is repealing a bylaw made on the 13th day of January intitaled "a bylaw to raise a certain amount by rate for county purposes for the current year" and authorizing the raising of a rate of one eighth of a penny on the pound for county purposes for the current year, be approved.

Carried unanimously.
