BYLAW NO.12

At a special session held in Havelock on Wednesday the 19th day of February, 1862, at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon, at which session are present His Worship Warden George Bryson, mayor of Mansfield, and the following county councillors:

- John Coghlan mayor of Allumette Island
- James McCool mayor of Chichester
- Michael Downie mayor of Sheen
- John F. Coghlan mayor of Waltham
- Francis Bastien mayor of Calumet Island
- Thomas McVeagh mayor of Litchfield
- Thomas Smart mayor of Clarendon
- William Craig mayor of Bristol
- Walton Smith mayor of Onslow
- James Martin mayor of Thorne & Leslie

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Moved by Mayor Smart, seconded by Mayor Martin that the county rate for the current year be calculated at one sixteenth of a penny on the pound on the valuation roll of each local municipality, that the secretary-treasurer do calculate the various amounts and that the bylaw be passed accordingly.

A bylaw in accordance with the last resolution levying the following accounts was then formed and passed:
