BYLAW NO.14

At a special session held in the village of Havelock on Thursday the 28th day of May, 1863, at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon, at which meeting are present Francis Bastien, mayor of Calumet Island, acting as warden, and the following county councillors:

- John Coghlan mayor of Allumette Island
- William Craig mayor of Bristol
- Thomas Smart mayor of Clarendon
- John F. Coghlan mayor of Waltham

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

A bylaw to raise by rate the sum of two hundred and seventy-three dollars (\$273) for the purpose of defraying the expenses of this council for the current year.

It is expedient and it is hereby enacted that the sum of two hundred and seventy-three dollars (\$273) be raised by rate for the expenses of this council for the year ending 30th June 1863, and that each of the local municipalities forming this county do pay their quota of the said sum, the amounts set forth against each of them respectively:

- Onslow \$47.00
- Bristol 38.00
- Clarendon 64.00
- Litchfield 30.00
- Thorne & Leslie 7.00
- Mansfield 11.00
- Calumet Island 18.00
- Allumette Island 25.00
- Waltham 7.00
- Chichester 10.00
- Sheen 6.00
- Portage du Fort 10.00
