BYLAW NO.15

At a quarterly session held in Havelock on Wednesday the 8th day of June, 1864, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden, William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

- Thomas McVeagh mayor of Litchfield
- George Bryson mayor of Mansfield
- John Meldrum mayor of Bristol
- Edward Carlin mayor of Sheen
- James Martin mayor of Thorne & Leslie
- William McDowell mayor of Clarendon
- James McCool mayor of Chichester

The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to raise by rate the sum of one hundred and seventy dollars and fifty cents (\$170.50) for the purpose of defraying the expenses of this council for the current year and a half."

It is expedient and it is hereby enacted that the sum of one hundred and seventy dollars and fifty cents (\$170.50) be raised by rate for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the council for the current year and a half ending the 31st December, 1864, and that the said amount be raised by levying one sixteenth of a cent on the dollar on the assessable property in each township and that each of the local municipalities forming the county do pay as it's quota of the said sum at the said rate of one sixteenth of a cent on the dollar on it's valuation:
