BYLAW NO.16

At a general half yearly session held at Havelock on Wednesday the 14th day of December, 1864, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to limit the regular session of this council to two in each year."

It is expedient and it is hereby enacted that in futur the regular meetings of this council be limited to two in each year that is to say on the second Wednesday of each of the months of May and December.
