BYLAW NO.17

At a general half yearly session held in Havelock, on Wednesday the 10th day of May, 1865, at the hour of ten o'clock in the forenoon, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to raise by rate the sum of two hundred and thirty three dollars and forty-four cents (\$233.44) for the purpose of defraying the current expenses of the council for the year 1865"

It is expedient and it is therefore enacted that the sum of two hundred and thirty-three dollars and forty-four cents (\$233.44) be raised by rate for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the council for the current year, 1865, and that the said sum be raised by a rate of one fifteenth of a cent on the dollar on all assessable property in each local municipality and that each said local municipality do pay as its quota of the said amount, the said rate of one fifteenth of a cent on the dollar on its valuation and that this bylaw do come in force forthwith.
