At a special session held in Havelock, Quebec, on Wednesday the 11th day of March, 1868, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw for amending the bylaw fixing the session of this council passed the 14th of December 1864"

It is expedient and it is hereby enacted that the by-law fixing the session of this council for the second Wednesday in each of the months of May and December be hereby amended, in so far as regards the month of May, and that the session of this council be in the futur held on the second Wednesday of the month of June and December.
