BYLAW NO.22

At a special session held Havelock on the 9th day of March 1870, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden William O'Meara, mayor of Portage du Fort, and the following county councillors:

- Terence Duff mayor of Allumette Island
- Michael Craig mayor of Sheen
- James McCool mayor of Chichester
- John F. Coghlan mayor of Waltham

- Walter Russell mayor of Bristol
- William Logue mayor of Onslow
- Simon McNally mayor of Calumet Island
- William McDowell mayor of Clarendon

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

The said council doth hereby ordain and make the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to amend a bylaw made and passed on the 11th day of March, 1868, intitulated "A bylaw amending the bylaw for fixing the sessions of this council."

It is expedient and it is hereby enacted that the said bylaw be rescinded and that the meetings of this council be in future held quarterly as provided by law.

Passed accordingly.
