BYLAW NO 1 UNDER THE MUNICIPAL CODE

At a general session held at Havelock on Wednesday the thirteenth day of March, 1872, at which session are present Walton Smith, mayor of Onslow, presiding as warden and the following councillors:

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer also being present.

The said council doth make and ordain the following bylaw:

"A bylaw to levy and impose the county rate for the current year."

It is expedient and be it hereby enacted that a tax be levied on each municipality in the county of one hundredth of a cent on the dollar on every dollar of property mentioned and assessed in the general assessment rolls for county purposes said rate raising a sum of six hundred dollars (\$600) for the purposes of this year one thousand eight hundred seventy and two.
