At the general session held at Havelock on Wednesday the twelfth day of June, 1872, at which meeting are present:

"A bylaw to purchase a new safe and register for the Registry office of this county, said purchase as also the disposal of the present safe by sale or exchange to be effected by the following gentlemen appointed hereby a committee for that purpose with the warden, the secretary-treasurer and the registrar, and also the future maintenance of said Registry office.

It is expedient and is hereby enacted that the following gentlemen be and are hereby appointed a committee to purchase a new safe and register for the Registry office as also to effect the disposal of the present safe by sale or exchange the necessary funds to be paid out of the general fund belonging to this council & the future maintenance of said registry office shall be provided out of the said general fund as from time to time may be required."
