BYLAW NO.3

At a general session held at the usual time and place on Wednesday the 12th day of March, 1873, at which meeting are present His worship Walton Smith, mayor of Onslow, and the following county councillors:

forming a quorum of council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

A bylaw for taking stock in the Capital stock of the Montreal Northern Railway Company for the purpose of building a railway from Aylmer as far up through the county as practicable. The council agree to invest \$150,000.00 in that railway company for that purpose.

Moved by mayor Proudfoot, seconded by mayor Coghlan that the bylaw be now read a second time.

Carried.

Bylaw is read a second time.

Moved by mayor Rimer, seconded by mayor McVeagh that bylaw be read a third time.

Carried

Bylaw is read a third time and declared passed.
