BYLAW NO. 4

At a general session held at the usual time and place on Wednesday the 12th day of March, 1873, at which meeting are present His Worship Warden Walton Smith, mayor of Onslow, and the following county councillors:

forming a quorum of Council. The secretary-treasurer being also present.

Moved by mayor Russell, seconded by mayor Poupore and resolved that a bylaw be formed to levy the sum of 500,00\$ by a rate of one twentieth of a cent on the dollar on every dollar of property mentioned and described in the valuation rolls of the municipalities in the county for the general purposes of this council for the current year, 1873.
