BYLAW NO. 5

At the general quarterly session held at their usual place of sitting on Wednesday the eleventh day of March, 1874, at which meeting are present:

and forming a quorum of council. Walton Smith presiding as warden. The said council doth make and ordain the following bylaw:

A bylaw for raising a certain sum to defray the ordinary expenses of this council for the current year.

WHEREAS it is expedient that a certain sum of money be raised by a rate upon the local municipalities of the county to defray the general expenses of this council for the current year. It is expedient and be it hereby enacted that the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars be levied and collected by a rate of one sixtieth of a cent on the dollar on every dollar of property mentioned and described in the valuation rolls of the local municipalities in the county, and that based upon said rate the said municipalities do pay the amounts proportioned as follows, that is to say:

- The municipality of Allumette Island 24,30\$
- The municipality of Thorne 6,40\$
- The municipality of Chichester 12,60\$
- The municipality of Portage du Fort 15,50\$
- The municipality of Calumet Island 15,50\$
- The municipality of Sheen 18,70\$
- The municipality of Mansfield 12,30\$
- The municipality of Waltham 6,60\$
- The municipality of Clarendon 48,60\$
- The municipality of Bristol 31,20\$
- The municipality of Onslow 27,60\$

- The municipality of Litchfield 17,30\$
- The municipality of Bryson 9,30\$
- The municipality of Leslie 6,50\$

Making in all the said sum of two hundred and fifty dollars.
