3 simple rules:

It's Edible

(or it's part of something that is edible)

It's made of paper or cardboard

(clean or soiled, non-waxed)

It's a yard waste

(except branches)

☑ Accepted Materials

FOOD WASTE

Food (cooked or raw, fresh or spoiled, including sauces), meats, bones, fish, dairy products, seafood and shells, coffee (grounds and filters), tea bags, pastries and sweets.

GREEN WASTE

Dead leaves, grass clippings, garden waste and twigs less than 30 cm long.

SOILED PAPER AND CARDBOARD

Pizza and other boxes (non-waxed, without plastic or staples), tissues, paper towels (without chemical products), and cardboard tableware.

OTHER MATERIALS

Cold ashes, hair and fur, wooden toothpicks, pet litter and droppings (loose or in paper bags only).

☒ Refused Materials

ALL PLASTIC BAGS, BIODEGRADABLE OR COMPOSTABLE

Diapers and feminine hygiene products, medications, dust, dryer lint, vacuum bags and contents, dead animals, waxed cardboard, cotton swabs, dental floss, candles, glass, plastic, metal, branches, rocks, gravel, concrete, asphalt, treated, stained or painted wood, etc.
